ESSENTIALGUIDE

Slip stitch(sl st)/single crochet



Insert the hook from front to back under the top of the second chain from the hook. Wrap the varn round the hook (yrh).



Pull the yarn through both of the loops on the hook to make a slip stitch. To carry on working a row of slip stitch, insert the hook into the next chain down and so on, repeating step 2 each time.

Double crochet (dc)



Skip 2ch and insert the hook under the top loop of the 3rd ch.

Wind the yarn around the hook and pull it through the chain loop. Leaving two loops on your crochet hook.



Yrh again, then pull the yarn through both loops. There's your double crochet (dc) made and you'll have one loop left on your hook ready to do the next stitch. To do a row of dc, continue to end of chain sts.



For the following rows of dc, turn work and ch1. This is the turning chain (t-ch) and counts as the first dc. Skip the stitch, at the base of the t-ch, then work 1dc under the top 2 loops of each stitch to the end, including top of t-ch on following rows.
