

Joined/separate rounds

Make a foundation ring then work the correct number of chains for the t-ch, for example, 3 ch for a treble.

Work the stitch as you would on a row, but this time insert the hook into the centre of the ring rather than the chain loop.


To close the round, work a slip stitch into the top of the turning chain.

Before working another round, make the required turning chain.

Yarn loop foundation ring

Make a loop in the yarn. Hold the bottom of the loop with the fingers which would normally hold the work. Insert the hook through the loop, yrh and pull through.

Make the correct turning chain (chain 1 for double crochet) and work the first round into the loop ring, encasing the short end of the yarn. Close the round with a sl st. Close up the centre of the ring by drawing the short end of the yarn tight. Secure it by weaving it into the wrong side of the work.
